assessment platform by undertaking one/two online readiness tests. Each test will take about 45 minutes to complete. This trial, called the School Readiness Test (SRT) will enable us to assess our technical readiness to implement the new online assessments in 2019. It will help us ensure that we have adequate internet connectivity.

The readiness test has not been constructed to assess curriculum knowledge, but rather to provide students with an opportunity to experience the types of questions that will be included in the new online assessments. As such, reports will not be provided. If you have any questions about this trial, please speak to Mrs Jolliffe or Mrs Garton.
