When we sat down to 'write' her letter I suggested that she draw some pictures of the items for Santa so that he would know exactly what she meant, this is a useful strategy for pre-writers and helps to get around the, "But I can't write," response that you may encounter with little ones. After drawing her pictures, Immy turned over her sheet and 'wrote' some further items on her list, verbally narrating as she went. She then added her name and LOTS of kisses! And off she went for a walk to the post box to post her letter to Santa!

Address your letter to:


Santa Claus, North Pole, 9999.
