



#### **Semester One Student Reporting**

In recognition of the disruption to teaching and learning that has occurred in Semester One, the Department of Education has confirmed that schools are not required to report on student achievement using a 5-point A-E scale for this semester only. This means that Clifton Park Primary School has a modified plan for reporting in Semester One which has been developed in consultation with our School Council. ## School Development Days – Monday $20^{\text{th}}$ and Tuesday $21^{\text{st}}$ July

The Department of Education also announced that schools are able to re-schedule a School Development Day in lieu of the 28<sup>th</sup> April, in consultation with the School Council. Clifton Park PS will now have two School Development Days at the beginning of Term Three, meaning that students will resume on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> July.

#### **Parent Survey**

We had approximately 60% of our families respond to our recent Parent Survey, which is a fantastic response. This has given us exceptional data to use as we continue to improve. It was really pleasing to see the following results:

99%	of respondents <b>agree</b> or <b>strongly agree</b> that the school looks for ways to improve.	96%	of respondents <b>agree</b> or <b>strongly agree</b> that the school provides rationale behind decisions that have impacts on students.
96%	of respondents <b>agree</b> or <b>strongly agree</b> that they feel well informed about the activities of this school.	67%	of respondents <b>agree</b> or <b>strongly agree</b> that they understand the role of the School Council and how they support them as a parent.
<b>76%</b>	of respondents <b>disagree</b> or <b>strongly disagree</b> that they would prefer the newsletter in paper form.	80%	of respondents <b>agree</b> or <b>strongly agree</b> that our facilities and resources enable our school to provide contemporary learning experiences.

I look forward to looking deeper into these survey results with the School Council over the coming weeks as we prepare for our Independent Public School selection process.

#### **Ongoing COVID-19 Response**

We continue to have a range of strategies in place at school to ensure our school is a safe and healthy learning environment for our students, and a safe work environment for our staff. I would like to sincerely thank our community for their ongoing support as we follow through on guidelines and implement operational procedures that need to be in place.
