Forms are available to be downloaded from the ENA & Dept. of Sport websites, or from your local Shire office. All forms are to be validated by your local Shire Office. Once your validated form has been received by ENA and we have received the reimbursement from the appropriate Shire, you will receive a refund of monies to the value of the funds available to that player on the validated voucher. \*\*It is the parents' responsibility to follow up on Kidsport vouchers with their local Shire and to lodge them with ENA.
