All students of our school are invited to be part of a group to march in the City of Bunbury ANZAC Day Parade. This will take place on *Wednesday 25 April 2018* (second week of school holidays). Students will need to assemble with Mrs Gerace outside the old RSL building on the corner of Edward and Spencer Streets by *10:20am*. The group will march from this location to the Bricknell Shell, where the service will be held.

The group of students representing our school must be in school uniform, including wearing a hat. (Students are encouraged to wear service decorations of family members on the right hand side of their uniform. They may also wear their Clifton Gold/Silver/Bronze medals). The weather can still be hot so students may carry a water bottle with them as they march.

Family members can join with the group and march with their child/ren, or make their way to the Bricknell Shell to listen to the ceremony. At the conclusion of the ceremony the students will stay at the Bricknell Shell.

- The students will remain under the care of the school staff until they are signed out by their parent/guardian.

NAPLAN


The Years 3 and 5 students will be participating in the NAPLAN testing programme during the third week of next term (15-17 May). Information will be handed to students to bring home this week.
