CITY OF BUNBURY ANZAC DAY MARCH - THURSDAY 25 APRIL

All students of our school are invited to be part of a group to march at the Bunbury ANZAC Day Service on Thursday April 25 (this is during the second week of the school holidays). Students will need to assemble with Mrs Gerace and Mrs Jolliffe outside the old RSL building on the corner of Edward and Spencer Streets by *10:20am*, ready to commence the march at 10:40am. The group will march to the Bricknell Shell, where the service will be held. Our Head Girl and Head Boy will be laying a wreath on behalf of the school.

The group of students representing our school must be in full school uniform, including wearing a hat. Students are encouraged to wear service decorations of family members on the right hand side of their uniform. They may also wear their Clifton Gold/Silver/Bronze medals and leadership badges. The weather can still be hot so students may carry a water bottle with them as they march.

Family members can join with the group and march with their child/ren, or make their way separately to the Bricknell Shell to listen to the ceremony.

- At the conclusion of the ceremony the students will stay at the Bricknell Shell.
- The group will NOT be marching away.
- Parents are asked to take over the care of their child/ren immediately the ceremony concludes.
- Students will remain under the care of school staff until they are signed out by their parent/guardian.
